

POKER RIDE RULES

- No dogs or stallions allowed on trail.
- This is not a race. When approaching or leaving other riders and checkpoints, do so in a slow and controlled manner. NEVER trot/canter up behind or away from other riders. This is not a timed event. Enjoy the ride.
- Riders please be aware that you may encounter non-motorized (mountain bikes) or hikers while riding.
- At each checkpoint participants hand poker score card(s) to organizer and then draw a card. This will be marked on the score card. If more than one score card, draw another card for each score card. After drawing replace all cards. If a card is drawn that is a duplicate of a card already on your score card, replace card and re-draw. It is the participant's responsibility to ensure score cards are marked correctly before proceeding to next check point.
- Winning Poker Score Card will be determined using standard poker hand rankings to determine the winning hands. In the event of a tie, winners will be determined by drawing for high card. For example, if there are two participants with the same hand, they will draw a card with the high card winning and the other taking second place. In the event there are more than two tied with the same hand, the above procedure will be followed until all prizes are awarded.
- Lunch will be served noon 'til 3:00 pm.
- Prizes and raffle drawings will begin at 2:00 pm. All participants need to be present to win.
